2017 was a great year at Watoto Wasoka, all thanks to your generosity! Every single penny donated helped us to empower, mobilise and educate slum kids through football. We brought fun and learning to more than 4,000 kids around Uganda through our football programmes.

- We organised the second Primary Schools League with over 500 kids through 22 schools
- The Slums Derby had over 700 kids for a weekend of football, fun and learning.
- We hosted **Coaches Across Continents** for a week with over 80 community coaches.
- Our Sparta 09 teams did well, we also won the U15's Kampala Regional League championship.
- Football 4 WASH remains our biggest social impact. We now have a masters' thesis on it.
- Girls' football continues to rise, all our programmes have girls' categories now.
- Over 300 footballs given out to schools and community teams.
- Over 80 kids earned scholarships through the programmes

Founded in 2009, we're a non-profit, youth-led football for development organisation. We use football as a vehicle for social change in the lives of slum children in Uganda. We seek to change lives, one game at a time through structured football programs.

As one of our main support concepts, we facilitate access to primary and secondary education for slum children. Through our close ties with the slum football scene, public and private schools, we have a unique network which has enabled more than 600 kids to attend school which they would otherwise not have.

We offer health education (Football4WASH, HIV/AIDS, vocational training, school support and a place to call home/go-to during holidays or when times are rough.
